5. Paul **IS FLYING** to London on Monday morning.
6. Wait! I **WILL DRIVE** you to the station.
7. The English lesson **STARTS** at 8:45.
8. Are you still writing your essay? If you **FINISH** by 4pm, we can go for a walk.
9. I **AM GOING TO SEE** my mother in April.
